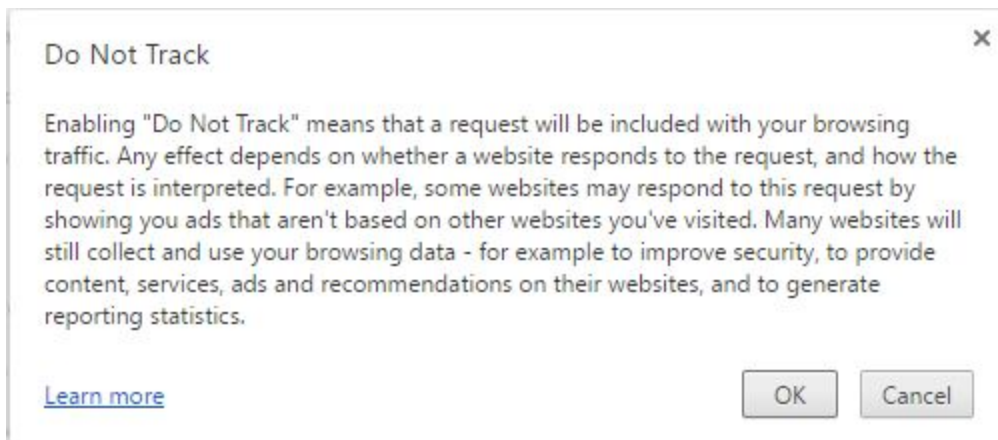

Here is one I learned this week. In your browser's advanced settings you can tell it DO NOT TRACK and when you search for something in your browser it will not tell the world you did so. In others words, you will not start getting ads for what you just looked for on Facebook and other places.



In each of the browsers there are add on programs called extensions. In Google Chrome you click the menu button (three ...) and choose Settings, then Extensions. Scroll to the bottom and select...

In the search box type the extension you are looking to add and it will display to the right. When you have found it simply click Add to Chrome. Here are some popular ones I use:



**AdBlock** 3.9.2

The most popular Chrome extension, with over 40 million users! Blocks ads all over the web.



**Show and Hide Passwords** 1.2

Show and Hide Passwords allows you to view and hide passwords on password fields.

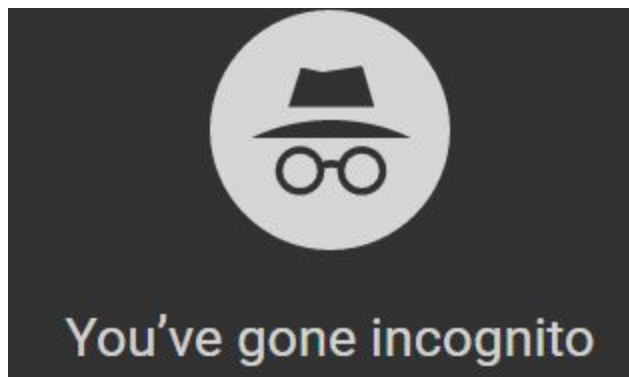


**Office Online** 1.5.0

View, edit, and create Office files in your browser.

To refresh a page try this shortcut: F5 Works with browsers and other windows.

Also to close an open window, use Alt+F4

If you do not own Microsoft Office, do you really need it? [LibreOffice](#) is a free download that will let you read and write in MS Office formatted files. It is a free download and works on Windows and Apple iOS. Under Settings for SaveAs change the format to .DOC or .DOCX so all your files will use the extension for MS Office. This way others can open your documents in Word or Excel. One caveat for LibreOffice is that it will open those old MS Works files.
