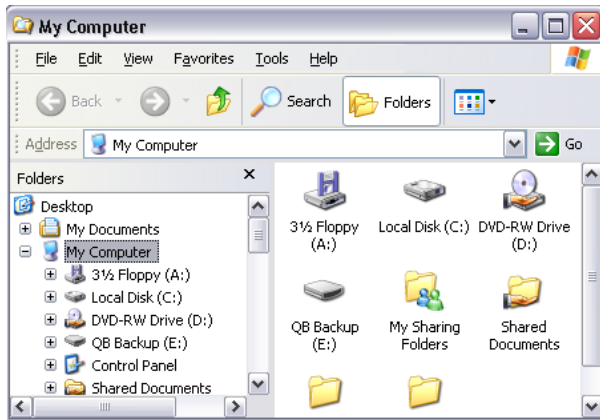


File Extensions not Displaying

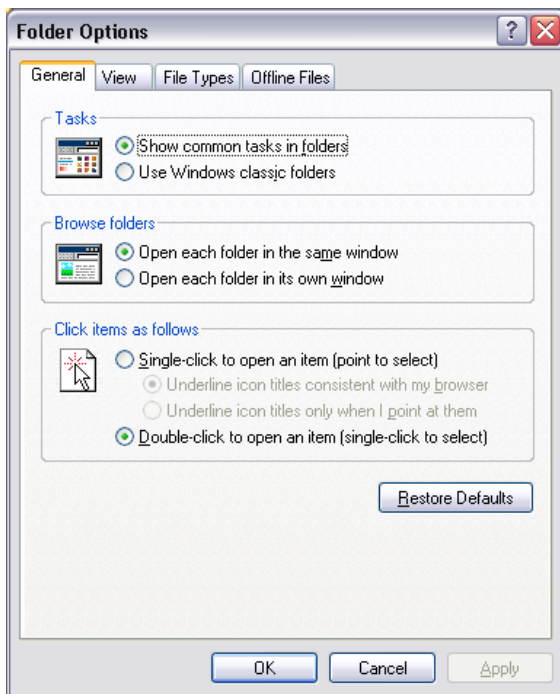
If the files are displaying in Windows Explorer with extensions follow these steps to add them

1. On the keyboard, press **Win+E** (the Windows key or Flag, then the letter E)

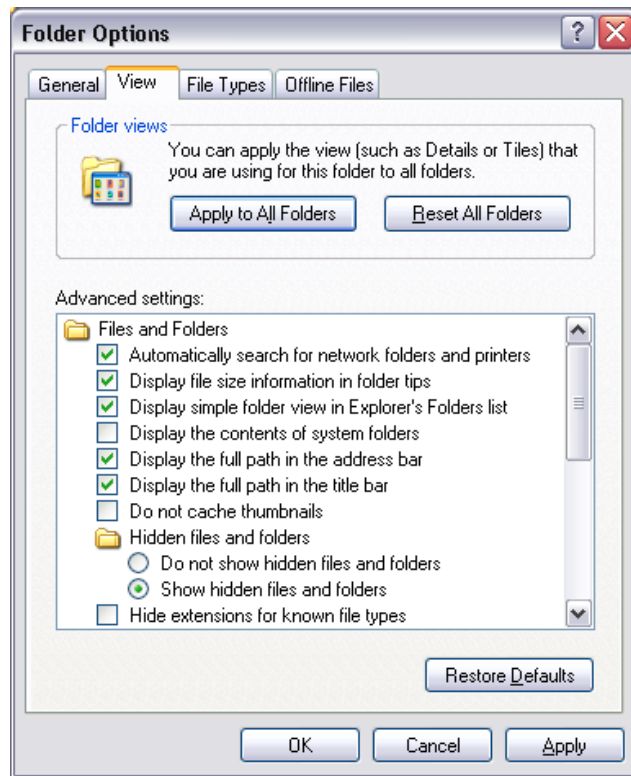


My Computer opens

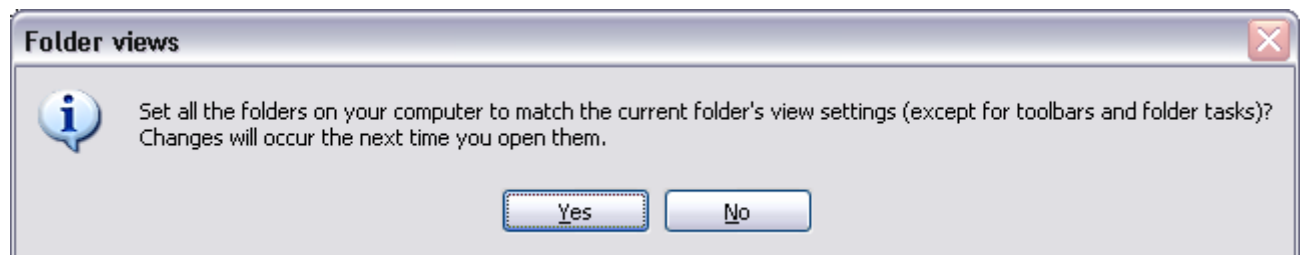
2. On the menu bar, click **Tools > Folder Options**



On the Folder Options dialog box, click the **View** tab



3. Under Advanced settings, check the "**Display the full path in the title bar**" box, click the "**Show hidden files and folders**" radio button, and then Uncheck the "**Hide extensions for known file types**" box
4. Under Folder views, click **Apply to All Folders**



5. At the informational dialog box, click **Yes**
6. On the Folder Options dialog box, click **OK**

All files will now display their extension and the full location of the file will display in the address bar
